OPERATIONS UPDATE – Steve Corbin, Production Supervisor reported on the following:

- 120 Customer Service Orders, 243 Dig Alerts, 4 Meter Upgrades, 7 Meters Replaced
- 7 Distribution Mainline Leaks, 19 Service Line Leaks, 22 Fire Flows, 7 New Service Installs, and 3 Service Line Replacements
- Distribution had an influx of leaks this month assisted with Well 14.
- Finished the front counter for customer service along with new offices in the old copy room.
- CIRP – All pipe is installed on Tilford with 31 services and 16 hydrants to install.
- Distribution and CIRP giving great assistance to Water Production during these times.
- Currently cross training to assist in Reservoir Inspection Runs.
